Taizé style Worship at the Cathedral

There will be a time of prayer around the cross in the Taizé tradition on Friday 20 March at 7pm. It will be led by Brother Paolo from the Taizé community, which is a monastic order in rural France, founded in 1940. Taizé services encourage an atmosphere of meditation and prayer, using repeated chants and prayers as well as other phrases from scripture. The community itself has a strong focus on peace and justice through prayer and meditation.
