Firstly, we would like to thank all our patients for their support and understanding during these unprecedented and challenging times. Please be mindful of the following:-

The Practice is currently offering telephone consultations only with the exception of face-to-face consultations at the request of a G.P.

Medication Requests -please do not order your repeat medication more than 7 days in advance. We will notify by text or telephone call when your medication is ready for collection. Please do not attend the Practice to collect beforehand. In accordance with NHS England we are unable to prescribe more than 28 days medication.

Please remember to follow the Government guidelines regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19), self-isolation and social distancing.

Eco Church

All Saints PCC recently completed an Eco Church online survey, to assess our environmental credentials, and to see the areas in which we need to improve. As you may know, we have been trying to bring our concerns about the environment to the fore, not just through our worship and teaching, but also through community involvement, with the 'green' theme to last year's Spring Fair and linking up with B-lines. Alas, this year it will not be possible to hold the Fair, but our work continues to promote 'green' concerns.

We are trying to reduce our carbon footprint in our energy use and to use renewable resources where possible. You may be aware too that we have been working to make the churchyard more bee/bird/bat friendly and have planted patches of native flowers in some of the grave surrounds. The survey, by the way, showed that we are at 'Bronze' level- so we are pleased to have started, but there's plenty of room for improvement!
