Reading David and Goliath

This story is from the Old Testament. It happened when Saul was King over God's people – their first King. The Israelites were fighting the Philistines. The Philistines had challenged the Israelites to fight their champion – whoever won in that fight would have won the war. The Israelites were all scared til along came shepherd boy, David.

Wondering questions

I wonder which part of this story you like the best?

I wonder what the soldiers thought about David when he said he would fight Goliath.

David defeated Goliath. I wonder what they said about him once David had won.

David knew that God had helped him before his famous fight. I wonder if you can think of times when God has helped you?

Activity

Goliath was ~9 feet tall and David was pretty small.

I wonder how tall you are?

Lie down on the ground. Put a stone to mark where your feet are and where the top of your head is.

Use a tape measure to measure how tall you are.

Put another stone for Goliath's feet and then measure out 9 ft (2.75m). Put a stone where his head would be.

I expect he is taller than you are! I wonder if you can work out how much taller he is.
