We are sorry for the times when we have done things that do not please you. [*pause*]

Lord have mercy **Lord have mercy**

May the God of love bring us back to himself, forgive us our sins, and assure us of his eternal love in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Reading Matthew 5:1-10

Once, Jesus went up a hill to teach people about his Father's kingdom. He told them that God blesses those who depend on him, and those who are humble he raises up. God's kingdom turns everything upside down and inside out. Jesus said something like this:


1. Blessed are those who rely on God's help; heaven is theirs
2. Blessed are those who are sad and upset; God will comfort them.
3. Blessed are those who don't show off but think of others first; they shall be given the earth;
4. Blessed are those who want fairness; God will satisfy them.
5. Blessed are those who are kind and forgiving to others; they will be given the same.
6. Blessed are those who try to please God in what they do and think; they will be with God.
7. Blessed are those who are peaceful and try to stop others fighting; God will call them his sons and daughters.
8. Blessed are people who get into trouble for doing the right thing; God's kingdom belongs to them.
