Community Lunch

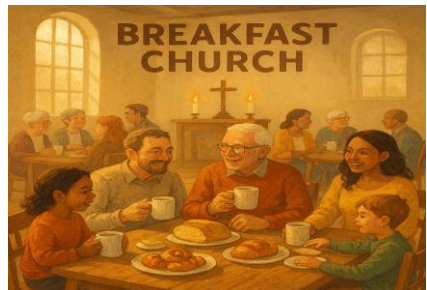
